

CONFIRMATION STUDENT WORKBOOK CLASS SYLLABUS

The Confirmation course will be offered in one (1) hour modules on a Sunday in the office conference room beginning at 11:45am. A modest lunch will be provided by the parents on a revolving schedule. Please pray about an appropriate "sponsor" for each youth and plan to have them attend the Introduction on September 6th with you and your "Confirmand." Conference calling is available to those unable to be there in person for that meeting as attendance is required. The date of the actual Confirmation ceremony next year will be announced when we are able to secure the Bishop. There is no cost for the program but commitment is most important. Parents and sponsors are to make sure that each Confirmand is prepared each week in the provided Handbook and that the readings from the Book of Common Prayer and the Bible are being accomplished.

Parents may enjoy the beach, relax on the church grounds (ie. Fish, bike, go to a restaurant) or run any errands before the class ends at 1pm. On selected dates, the confirmation class will begin later at 4pm, followed by a fun youth experience called "YAM."
